II. Tasks

- Adopting and supervising the implementation of the short, medium and long-term action plans of the Sector in line with the Organization's strategic plan;
- Using the outputs of STI in knowledge and expertise transfer and exchange in Member States;
- Launching the initiatives and projects aiming to consolidate science-society relationship with a view to enriching society, facilitating people's life, and increasing income and living standard in Member States;
